Atlantic City teen found shot Wednesday morning

ATLANTIC CITY — Police found a 17-year-old with a gunshot wound on Caspian Avenue early Wednesday morning.

Just before 2 a.m., patrol officers responded to the 1300 block of Caspian Avenue for an alert by the city's ShotSpotter gunshot-audio detection system.

The victim, whom police did not identify, had a nonlife-threatening gunshot wound. He was taken to AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Campus.



The investigation is being led by the Atlantic City Police Department Violent Crimes Unit. Anyone with information about the shooting can call the Violent Crimes Unit at 609-347-5788. Information also can be texted to tip411 (847411). Begin the text with ACPD. All texts are anonymous.
