



Victim in fatal city shooting on Sunday identified

Lamell Stukes, 26, killed; Anthony Montgomery charged with murder

City police have identified the victim in a fatal shooting and have arrested a suspect.

Officers were called around 2 a.m. Sunday to the 100 block of North Smallwood Street on a reported shooting.

Officers said they found a 26-year-old gunshot wound victim. He was taken to Bon Seccours Hospital for treatment. The victim died shortly after arrival, officers said. Police identified the man on Monday as Lamell Stukes.

Detectives identified 27-year-old Anthony Montgomery as a suspect in the fatal shooting and obtained an arrest warrant. Montgomery was taken into custody around 12:15 p.m. Monday at a grocery store in the 2100 block of West Lexington Street.

Montgomery was charged with first-degree murder and was taken to Central Booking.

Police said a photo of Montgomery will be made available later.
