Plainclothes NYPD cop shot in head in Queens by pellet gun

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NYPD Officer Injured in Possible Pellet Gun Attack

A plainclothes NYPD detective was shot in the head by a pellet gun while driving through Queens Wednesday afternoon, police said.

The detective was driving west in an unmarked car on 168th St. by Jamaica Ave. in Jamaica just after 5:10 p.m., when a motorist going the opposite direction opened fire with an air gun, striking him in the head, cops said.

The detective was taken to Jamaica Hospital with injuries that are not considered life-threatening, cops said.

Police were still looking for the shooter Wednesday afternoon and wouldn't speculate on motive.

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
